RE: TURF REVOLUTION ORGANIC LAWN FERTILIZER

In the season of 2005 we started using Turf Revolution Organic Lawn Fertilizers on one of our soccer fields. In the past, the existing field had 2 applications of synthetic fertilizer applied in the spring and fall. The City of Windsor was looking for an alternative due to the new By Law, which takes effect in January of 2009 eliminating the use of chemicals on all residential and commercial lawns. Turf Revolution 5-1-5 Alfalfa and Easy -Flo Compost was applied for the first time in the spring and fall of 2005.

The second season we applied 5-1-5 Alfalfa in the spring and fall. We also over seeded and did spring and fall aeration. The results of the field were very satisfactory. We are continuing to use these products in the future and are looking at expanding it to other fields. One other product we use is the Horticulture Vinegar. The vinegar is used in parking lots, landscape beds, play areas and city sidewalks to clean the areas of any unwanted vegetation.

Moving to organic has assisted the City of Windsor in meeting its goals to reduce pesticide use and creating a healthier environment.
